# Interstate 215 Widening

- Project area – 7.5 mile stretch from Orange Show Road to University Parkway
- Addition of one general use and carpool lane in each direction from Orange Show Road to 27<sup>th</sup> Street
- New connectors between I-215 and SR-210
- Estimated completion date – 2013
- Total project cost – Approximately \$723 million (\$77 million under estimates)





# 5<sup>th</sup> Street Bridge Reconstruction

February 2007 – November 2008

- **Status: Completed**
- **\$23 million project (approximately \$2 million under budget)**





Early 2008 - Mid 2010

- **Status: Nearing completion**
- **Estimated cost : \$180 million**

Late 2009 – Late 2013

## Late 2009 – Late 2013

- **Status: Construction well underway**
- **Total estimated cost : \$347 million (\$77 million under estimates!)**
- **Reconstruct five bridges/underpasses**
- **Build 12 on- and off-ramps**

# Rialto Ave. to Massachusetts Ave.

Late 2009 - Late 2013

## Bridges/Underpasses Under Construction:

- 2nd Street – Widen underpass; new NB & SB on-ramps, NB off-ramp
- 3rd Street - Widen underpass
- 5th Street – New direct NB & SB on- and off-ramps will replace 4th Street on-ramps, which are currently closed

# Rialto Ave. to Massachusetts Ave.

Late 2009 – Late 2013

## Bridges/Underpasses Under Construction:

- 9th Street – Closed October 2009 until late 2010 for reconstruction; bridge demolished January 2010
- Baseline Avenue – New direct NB & SB on- and off-ramps, eliminates 10th & Orange Street on-ramps and 13th street off-ramps; one lane in each direction during two-year reconstruction; temporary I-215 SB exit off of SR-259
- 16th Street – Reconstruct bridge





# Massachusetts Ave. to University Pkwy.

January 2010 – Mid 2013

- **Status: Under Construction**
- **Approximate total cost – \$159 million**
- **Reconstruct three bridges**
- **Connector ramps will link eastbound SR-210 to southbound I-215, and northbound I-215 to westbound SR-210**

# Massachusetts Ave. to University Pkwy. January 2010 – Mid 2013

## Bridges/Underpasses Under Construction:

- Massachusetts Avenue - Reconstruct bridge during a later phase
- Highland Avenue – One lane in each direction during two-year reconstruction; NB off-ramp closed during construction; NB on-ramp long-term closure
- 27th Street/Mt. Vernon Avenue – Reconstruct bridge during a later phase
