



I-215 WIDENING PROJECT

Southbound I-215 5th Street Off-Ramp Closure Public Information Meeting



Purpose

As part of the Interstate 215 Widening Project, San Bernardino Associated Governments (SANBAG) will host a public information meeting to discuss plans that will expedite the construction completion timeline by approximately seven months for work between Rialto and Massachusetts avenues.

The meeting will be held Tuesday, June 8, 2010 and will have project engineers and team members on hand to inform attendees and answer questions about the southbound I-215 5th Street off-ramp closure that will be needed to expedite the project. A brief project overview will be given at 6:15 p.m.

Detour plans (which will include southbound I-215 traffic off at 3rd Street onto a new frontage road), timing of closures, traffic impacts, and business outreach will be shared at the meeting.
