Freeway Widening Project

Construction crews are working day and night on the freeway and surrounding bridges. The freeway will be under construction through 2013.

Do your part to play it safe and keep your distance from construction sites. Obey safety signs and be careful crossing over bridges or near the freeway.



MESSAGE TO PARENTS

San Bernardino Associated Governments (SANBAG) and the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) are working as partners on the \$800 million Interstate 215 Widening Project.

Funded by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 and a combination of federal, state and local Measure I sales tax funds, the project is estimated to be completed by 2013. The project will:

- ▶ Add two freeway lanes in each direction.
- ▶ Widen and lengthen existing freeway bridges.
- ▶ Improve access and enhance safety by removing entrances and exits from the fast lane.
- ▶ Add an auxiliary lane in each direction between 5th Street and the State Route 259 split, and between 2nd Street and Mill Street.
- ▶ Add sound walls and retaining walls.
- ▶ Add aesthetic elements and wallscapes.
