## NOTICE OF INFORMATIONAL CONTRACTORS WORKSHOP FOR DOWNTOWN SAN BERNARDINO PASSENGER RAIL & SAN BERNARDINO TRANSIT CENTER PROJECTS

The San Bernardino Associated Governments (SANBAG) invites contractors to an informational workshop for the Downtown San Bernardino Passenger Rail Project (DSBPRP) and the San Bernardino Transit Center Project (SBTC). Both projects are anticipated to be advertised by Invitation for Bid (IFB) in July or August. The workshop will provide a broad overview of both projects. The DSBPRP will extend Metrolink one mile from the San Bernardino Santa Fe Depot to the SBTC at Rialto Avenue and E Street. The project will include double-tracking and associated railroad signaling and communications, five train platforms, four grade crossings, a pedestrian overpass, a Metrolink crew building, parking lot modifications, utilities and storm drains, landscape and irrigation, security systems, signage, street improvements and a detention basin. The estimate cost for the DSBPRP is \$65 million. The SBTC is a 5 acre site consisting of a 22-bay bus transit center with a 7500 sq. ft. office/lobby/crew building, bus shelters, signage, security system, frontage street improvements including one signal controlled intersection, utilities, off-site storm drain, photovoltaic system, and landscape and irrigation. The estimated cost for SBTC is \$15 million.
