I. MEASURE I ELDERLY AND HANDICAPPED TRANSIT FUNDS

These funds shall not be used to supplant existing Federal, State, and local (Local Transportation Fund) funds committed to transit services.

II. MAINTENANCE OF EFFORT

The maintenance of effort shall be determined by calculating the amount of Local Transportation Fund (LTF) each jurisdiction contributed toward transit operating expenses in the fiscal year 1989/1990 adjusted by the Los Angeles, Riverside and Orange Counties area Consumer Price Index (CPI) for all items as determined by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.

III. EXCEPTIONS TO THE MAINTENANCE OF EFFORT POLICY

A. Maintenance of Effort Requirement That Applies to the County and a Newly Incorporated City or Town

The combined contribution of LTF by the County and the newly incorporated city or town to the transit operation subsidy must meet the maintenance of effort requirement that would have otherwise applied to the County alone. Subsequent maintenance of effort determinations shall be made by allocating the CPI adjusted maintenance of effort amount to the County and the newly incorporated city or town based upon the initial population used for apportioning LTF.

B. Maximum Use of LTF

A second exception would be that the maintenance of effort requirement will not apply if a jurisdiction is spending all of its LTF apportionment for transit purposes.
