PUBLIC MEETING for the INTERSTATE 10/CHERRY AVENUE INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Fontana – The Interstate 10/Cherry Avenue Interchange Improvement Project proposes capacity, operational and safety improvements to the existing Interstate 10/Cherry Avenue interchange in the City of Fontana. Two build alternatives are being considered, as well as the No-Build Alternative, which would not make any changes to the existing interchange.
