Nighttime Closures of Milliken Avenue Needed for Bridge Construction for Grade Separation Project

ONTARIO, CA – The City of Ontario and San Bernardino Associated Governments will require the closure of Milliken Avenue between Guasti Road and East Airport Avenue on Monday, January 23rd and Tuesday, January 24th between the hours of 9:00 pm and 5:00 am to allow for crews to set girders for the new railroad bridge being constructed over Milliken Avenue. These nighttime closures are a necessary for the safety of the motoring public and the men and women working on the project.

Detours will be signed and motorists are encouraged to use Haven Avenue to the west as an alternate route during these two nights of construction. Haven Avenue may be accessed from East Airport Avenue to the south and Inland Empire Boulevard to the north. There will be no impacts to the nearby Interstate 10 on and off ramps.

Additional nighttime (9:00 pm to 5:00 am) lane reductions of Milliken Avenue will continue throughout the week following the full closures, but no detour will be necessary since at least one lane will be open at all times.

The 'North Milliken Grade Separation Project' is an endeavor to separate rail traffic from vehicular traffic where the two systems cross just south of Interstate 10. Eliminating the at-grade crossing will increase safety, improve mobility and enhance the quality of life for those who live and work near Milliken Avenue in Ontario.
