Northbound Milliken Avenue to Close Additional Night for Grade Separation Project Effort

ONTARIO, CA – The City of Ontario and San Bernardino Associated Governments will require the closure of northbound Milliken Avenue between East Airport Avenue and Guasti Road tonight, Wednesday, January 25th from 8:30 pm to midnight to complete the girder placement and testing for the future Milliken Avenue bridge over the railroad line.

Originally, this effort was to be completed in two nights, but due to an equipment malfunction, crews will need approximately four hours to finish the work. Detours will be signed and motorists are encouraged to use Haven Avenue to the west as an alternate route during this unforeseen necessity. Haven Avenue may be accessed from East Airport Avenue to the south. There will be no impacts to the nearby Interstate 10 on and off ramps.

The 'North Milliken Grade Separation Project' is an endeavor to separate rail traffic from vehicular traffic where the two systems cross just south of Interstate 10. Eliminating the at-grade crossing will increase safety, improve mobility and enhance the quality of life for those who live and work near Milliken Avenue in Ontario.
