PROJECT UPDATE MEETING

PROJECT OVERVIEW

San Bernardino Associated Governments (SANBAG), the county's transportation authority and commission, is developing the Downtown San Bernardino Passenger Rail Project (DSBPRP) to expand mass transit options for residents in the San Bernardino Valley, to provide intermodal connectivity to local bus, bus rapid transit (BRT) and future rail connection to Redlands and to enhance economic revitalization efforts in Downtown San Bernardino.

As part of the project, two fully signalized Metrolink tracks will be extended one-mile from the Santa Fe Depot in San Bernardino to the planned San Bernardino Transit Center in downtown at Rialto Avenue and E Street. The project will also enhance pedestrian circulation and safety at the Santa Fe Depot and enhance motorist and pedestrian safety at the 3rd Street, 2nd Street, Rialto Avenue/ I Street and G Street grade crossings.

Construction of DSBPRP is anticipated to start in mid 2013 and operation to begin in early 2015. The project is a key component of a long-range transit plan to improve mobility throughout the region.

PURPOSE OF THE UPDATE MEETING

The purpose of this meeting is to provide the public another opportunity to continue to be informed about the planned project and the timing of construction activities. SANBAG invites residents, businesses, organizations, and agencies to attend the meeting and have discussions with project management.

Boards and renderings will also be on display to show highlights of the project including the construction of cul-de-sacs at I Street and 3rd Street at the existing railroad tracks.
