- ▶ San Bernardino County's Transportation Commission

  - ❑ Approves all capital projects for public transit
  
- ▶ As County Transportation Authority, Administers County-wide Measure I Funds for:
  - ❑ Commuter Rail service
  - ❑ Bus Rapid Transit/Express Bus service
  - ❑ Specialized transit service for seniors and persons with disabilities



# Short-Range Transit Plan

- ▶ SANBAG is developing a Short-Range Transit Plan (SRTP) to:
  - ❑ Guide transit service improvements over the next five years
  - ❑ Establish regional transit mobility goals, objectives, and service standards
  - ❑ Identify and address regional transit needs
  - ❑ Prioritize major capital improvement projects for the region's transportation needs

  - Goals, Objectives, and Standards
  - Identification of unmet needs
  - Service Plans
  - Capital Improvement Plans
  - Financial Plans

# Network Connectivity

- ▶ Coordinate with the transit operators to integrate the transit services of the various transit operators throughout the County
  - ❑ Establish common transfer point locations between their systems
  - ❑ Establish transfer and service coordination agreements to facilitate regional mobility
  - ❑ Coordinate schedules of connecting routes between transit systems, where appropriate




# Inter-Regional Transit

## ► Facilitate inter-regional transit travel


- ❑ Explore system of regional fares
- ❑ Consider regional on-line centralized transit information
- ❑ Expand regional vanpool services currently available in Victor Valley to cover all of San Bernardino County
- ❑ Partner with RCTC to expand the regional vanpool and carpool programs
- ❑ Work with VVTA, Omnitrans, and MARTA to study the potential demand for increased commuter services into the City of San Bernardino
- ❑ Current inter-regional services: Metrolink; VVTA's B-V Link; MARTA's "Off-the-Mountain", MBTA's 12/15




# MBTA-Area Daily Trips




# VVTA-Area Daily Trips




# MARTA-Area Daily Trips




# Omnitrans-East Valley Sub-Area




# Omnitrans San Bernardino Sub-Area

# Access for All

- ▶ Seek cost-effective programs to improve mobility for seniors and persons with disabilities
  - ❑ Provide for a Consolidated Transportation Services Agency
  - ❑ Expand the availability of:
    - Travel training
    - Transportation Reimbursement Escort Programs (TREP)
    - Social service agency transportation coordination
  - ❑ Encourage VTrans and transit operators to implement uniform methods for Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) paratransit certifications, which include in-person assessments, where appropriate



# Commuter Rail Service

- ▶ Support continued development and enhancement of commuter rail service in San Bernardino County
  - ❑ Work with Metrolink for the enhancements to the San Bernardino Line:
    - Increase service capacity
    - Additional weekday and weekend commuter rail service frequencies
    - Implement service extension to the new Downtown San Bernardino Transit Center
  - ❑ Work with Metrolink and Omnitrans to enhance multi-modal rail and transit service connections at the new Downtown San Bernardino Transit Center


