The Interstate 15 (I-15) Corridor Project Team would like to invite you to attend an Open House Project Information Meeting on Thursday, November 12, at the Ontario Airport Hotel & Conference Center located at 700 N Haven Ave., Ontario, CA 91764.

The I-15 Corridor Project would extend for approximately 14 miles. It would add one (1) Express Lane in each direction on I-15 between the Cantu-Galleano Ranch Road interchange and the State Route 60 (SR-60) interchange, add two (2) Express Lanes in each direction on I-15 between SR-60 and State Route 210 (SR-210), and add one (1) Express Lane in each direction between the SR-210 interchange and the Duncan Canyon Road interchange.

An open house style project information meeting will be held to provide an opportunity to ask questions of Project Team members regarding design features, the tentative schedule for the planned project, when future opportunities will occur for public review and input and when the project will be constructed.



Interstate 15 Corridor Project



WHAT'S BEING PLANNED	<p>San Bernardino Associated Governments (SANBAG), in cooperation with the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), is planning a corridor project on Interstate 15 (I-15).</p> <p>The I-15 Corridor Project would extend for approximately 14 miles. It would add one (1) Express Lane in each direction on I-15 between the Cantu-Galleano Ranch Road interchange and the State Route 60 (SR-60) interchange, add two (2) Express Lanes in each direction on I-15 between SR-60 and State Route 210 (SR-210), and add one (1) Express Lane in each direction between the SR-210 interchange and the Duncan Canyon Road interchange.</p> <p>The planned limits of the project extends through three (3) freeway-to-freeway system interchanges including SR-60 in the cities of Eastvale and Jurupa Valley in Riverside County, Interstate 10 (I-10) in the City of Ontario in San Bernardino County and SR-210 in the cities of Rancho Cucamonga and Fontana in San Bernardino County.</p> <p>The project limits at the southerly end would extend approximately 1.3 miles south of the Cantu-Galleano Ranch Road Overcrossing and at the northerly end would extend approximately 1.6 miles north of Duncan Canyon Road Overcrossing to provide for the placement of advanced signage for the Express Lanes.</p> <p>The purpose of the planned I-15 Corridor project is to increase capacity and enhance operations and mobility on I-15 from south of SR-60 to north of SR-210.</p>
