- - - DOWNTOWN SAN BERNARDINO PASSENGER RAIL PROJECT
 Completion: Summer 2016 **Total Project Cost: \$103 Million***
 Construction duration **28 months**
- SAN BERNARDINO TRANSIT CENTER
 Completion: Early 2015 **Total Project Cost: \$25 Million***
 Construction duration **12 months**
- - - sbX BUS RAPID TRANSIT
 Completion: Spring 2014 **Total Project Cost: \$191.7 Million***

PROJECT BENEFITS

DOWNTOWN SAN BERNARDINO PASSENGER RAIL PROJECT:

- Extends Metrolink service one-mile from the Santa Fe Depot to the multi-modal San Bernardino Transit Center
- Increases usage of the Santa Fe Depot
- Improves grade crossing safety
- Provides a link to additional transit options in San Bernardino, Redlands and Loma Linda
- Helps create an environment for sustainable communities
- Provide safe pedestrian overpass at the Santa Fe Depot
- Part of a strategy to meet AB 32 (Global Warming Solutions Act) and SB 375 (Sustainable Communities Strategies) goals
- Paves the way for a future commuter rail system to the City of Redlands

SAN BERNARDINO TRANSIT CENTER:

- Serves as a key multi-modal transportation hub linking a variety of transportation options including sbX, 13 local bus routes, regional transit providers, Metrolink and the future Redlands Passenger Rail Project
- Offers amenities including an enclosed lobby, public restroom and a customer service area
- Provides direct access to the 66ers baseball games
- Houses a 22-bay bus transit center
- Meets LEED Gold construction rating
- Incorporates local street improvements
