Nighttime Lane Closures Continue for Both Directions of Interstate 15 in Victorville

VICTORVILLE, CA – Progress continues on the La Mesa / Nisqualli Interchange Project as crews are working in the median for the center column that will support the future bridge over Interstate 15. Nighttime closures of the two inside lanes in both directions are scheduled for Friday night and Sunday night between 10:00 pm and 5:00 am. Motorists can also expect to see crews return to the night schedule on Tuesday and Wednesday nights as well.

These nighttime closures are critical for the safety of both the motorists and crew members as the project team conducts excavation and shoring activities. In addition, materials are trucked in at night for daytime pile driving activities.

No detour is required as one lane will remain open at all times. Motorists are encouraged to slow down in construction zones and seek alternative times of travel when possible.
